

LOS ANGELES PAPER QUILTS.

**Daily Morning Tribune Suspended
as "Not a Necessity."**

LOS ANGELES, Cal., July 4.—An-
nouncement was made today that The
Los Angeles Daily Morning Tribune "is
not a necessity in these war times, and
the money, material, and labor used in
its production should be conserved for
other important work," and that it
would discontinue publication with the
issue today.

"If the conditions justify after the
war the publication will be resumed,"
the announcement said.

The Tribune was established on July
4, 1911, by Edwin T. Earl, who also
owns The Evening Express.
